RULES & REGULATIONS

1. There is no limit on the number of entries per class, exhibitor, or farm
2. Exhibitors are responsible for their cattle & property for the duration of the show
3. Exhibitors must carry a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance
4. "Purebred" will be defined by the respective National Breed Associations
5. The committee reserves the right to check tattoos or registration papers as they deem necessary
6. All animals must have CCIA tags. Animals without appropriate tags will not be allowed on the fairgrounds.
7. Tie-outs are available on the grounds, straw is not provided (Do NOT use horse ring - Tie-outs will be on outer fences, ask committee for location)
8. Exhibitors MUST stay for the duration of the show or all earnings will be forfeited.
9. Junior exhibitors will be strictly prohibited from consuming alcohol for the duration of the junior show. Alcoholic Beverages for of-age adults must be served in a plastic cup, NO glass bottles!
10. Bulls over 3 months of age must use a humbug or nose ring during the show
11. Animals deemed to be of unfit health will be asked to leave
12. Any additional matters are at the discretion of the show committee
13. The committee's decision regarding any of the above-mentioned is final

JUNIOR SHOW

1. All Participants must be under 21 or under as of January 1, 2021
2. Age Divisions as follows:
 - Peewee – 8 & Under
 - Junior – 9-12
 - Intermediate – 13-16
 - Senior – 17 - 21
3. You must show in showmanship to participate in confirmation, however, a junior can borrow a calf for showmanship without being required to exhibit in confirmation
4. Cattle must be shown by an exhibitor entered in the show. Please note that the animal does not have to be shown by the junior under which they were entered
 - Class Divisions:
 - i. Heifer Calf (Born in 2021)
 - ii. Yearling Female (Born in 2020)
 - iii. Cow with her own natural calf at side (born in 2019 or older)
5. There is no minimum number of animals required to make a breed division. Divisions will be sorted as follows:
 - a. Angus
 - b. Charolais
 - c. Crossbred
 - d. Hereford
 - e. Limousin
 - f. Shorthorn
 - g. Simmental
 - h. Any Other Breeds
6. Junior exhibitors will be strictly prohibited from consuming alcohol for the duration of the junior show
7. The show committee has final decisions on all matters related to the above-mentioned regulations and any other matter not explicitly covered

OPEN SHOW

Breeds: Angus, Any Other Purebred Breed, Crossbred, Charolais, Hereford, Limousin, Shorthorn, Simmental

Bulls

1. Bull calf born on or after January 1st, 2021. Minimum of 3 months of age on the day of judging. Calves shown in the calf class are eligible to show as a unit with their Dam in the cow calf classes
2. Yearling bull born January 1st to December 31st 2020
3. 2 year old bull born January 1st to December 31st 2021

Females

4. Heifer calf born on or after January 1st 2021. Minimum of 3 months of age on the day of judging. Calves shown in the calf class are eligible to show as a unit with their Dam in the cow calf classes
5. Junior yearling heifer born March 1st to December 31st 2020
6. Senior yearling heifer born January 1st to February 28th 2020
7. Two year old cow born January 1st to December 31st 2019 shown with her own 2021 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Section 1 or 4 as well as group classes
8. Mature cow born prior to January 1st 2018 shown with her own 2020 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female and calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Section 1 or 4 as well as group classes
9. Progeny of dam – 2 animals with the same dam. Both animals must have been exhibited in previous classes.
10. Get of Sire – 3 animals with the same sire, both sexes represented. Animals must have been exhibited in previous classes.
11. Breeder's Herd – 4 animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented. Animals must have been exhibited in previous classes.

Please Note: for Grand Champion classes, 1st & 2nd place entries are asked to return. If a calf qualifies as an individual unit as well as with the cow as a pair, it will be up to the exhibitor to designate under which division the calf will return.
